

BEFORE READING Talk together

- Read the title together. Ask: What do you like to eat at a party?
- Look at the toys in the picture. Ask: What might Kipper give them to eat?
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

 Some words may be more challenging.
Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.

he wanted party nobody come toys cake cornflakes tomato sauce baked beans sugar cross sorry


DURING READING

Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the words:

- Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
- Model how to sound out and blend new words if necessary.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.








Kipper wanted a party.




Nobody wanted to come.

He put in jam.




He put in sugar.




He put in baked beans.
