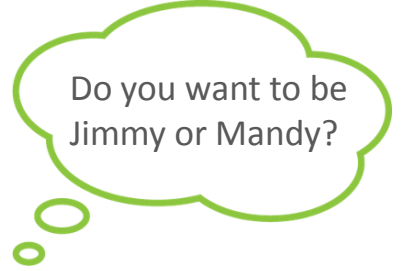


It's a beautiful day today. Would you like to go to the zoo with me?

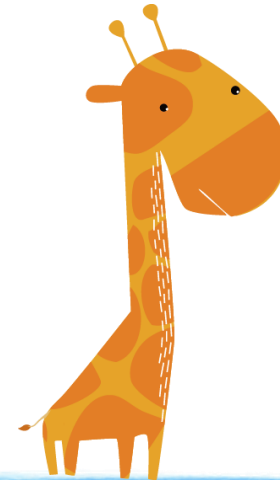
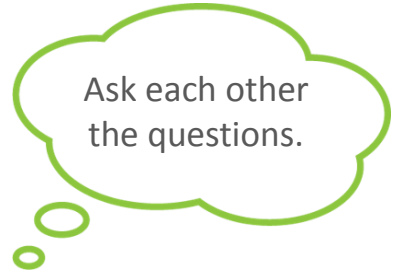
