1 Before you begin: Review the following sentence patterns for enjoy:

- 1. enjoy + -ing verb e.g. I enjoy surfing the Internet.
- 2. enjoy + reflexive pronoun e.g. I enjoyed myself in Bali last summer.

Teaching Notes

Target Structure:	<i>Enjoy</i> + gerund or reflexive pronoun
Vocabulary:	General
Level:	Elementary
Time:	20 minutes
Preparation:	None

Suggested Teaching Method:

This worksheet gives extra practice of 'enjoy'. This verb needs either a reflexive pronoun (I enjoyed myself) or a direct object (I enjoyed the TV show).

- 1 Review the target structures, checking understanding.
- 2 Model the practice exercise. Explain that the students need to think of a suitable verb.
- 3 Model exercise three. Students need to choose a suitable preposition.
- 4 Students should read their answers to exercise four to each other in pairs.
