Suggested Teaching Method:

This worksheet gives extra practice of 'enjoy'. This verb needs either a reflexive pronoun (I enjoyed myself) or a direct object (I enjoyed the TV show).

- Review the target structures, checking understanding.
- Model the practice exercise. Explain that the students need to think of a suitable verb.
- Model exercise three. Students need to choose a suitable preposition.
- Students should read their answers to exercise four to each other in pairs.
