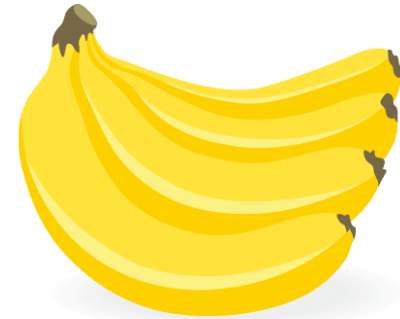
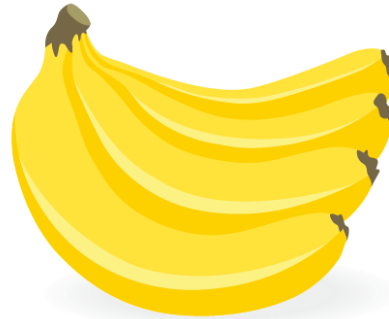
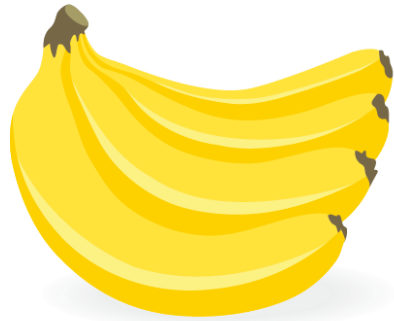

No, it 's not 22. When we **multiply** 6 by 4, we get 24.
